

Very rare example of a lavishly produced trade catalogue of a photographer's business specialized in children portraiture with examples of its work and 14 photographic interior and exterior views of the studio in Frankfurt am Main, Kaiserstrasse 34. Six original mounted photographs with portraits of women, children and men in carefully arranged and decorated studio settings. Otto van Bosch (18??–1895) was a German portrait and royal court photographer. He was active at least from 1868 onwards when he got a price medal for participating in the second photographic exhibition in Frankfurt. He owned two studios, both known as "van Bosch" one in Frankfurt am Main (1860s–1890s), the other in Paris, 35 boulevard des Capucines (1880–1887). This studio was taken over in 1888 by Paul Boyer, who was active until ca 1909. A fine copy.



Not in the Berlin catalogue. UCBA III, 24. First edition. Title with two small stamps of a Danish military library. Johann Gotthilf Angermann born 1736 in Halle (nothing more known) introduces himself on the title as "Koenigl. Preuss. Land-Bau-Meister des Fuerstenthums Minden, und der Graffschaften Ravensberg, Lingen und Tecklenburg". The present work is an extensive compendium of material knowledge for the future builder, with practical instructions for the cost-saving and effective use of the various building materials. The second part contains detailed estimates for a house, a starch house, a barn, a shed for sheep, a farmhouse, among others, all structures illustrated on the plates. A fresh and clean copy.

UCBA III, 122. First edition. Franz Ludwig von Cancrin (1738–1816), was an engineer and director of the court's building authority of Landgrave Wilhelm I of Hessen-Kassel, for whom he designed and built the famous Wilhelmsbad in Hanau. He was also director of the mint, the salt

mines near Bad Nauheim and the Hassian mines, until he split up with him, and was thereupon engaged by the Tsarina Catherine II as director of the saltworks in Staraya Russa near Novgorod where he died in 1816. In his "Grundlehren der Buergerlichen Baukunst" all kinds of buildings are described in minute details with all their decorations, variations in size, and construction principles which are all shown on the plates. "Auf Sukkow fussend veröffentlichte Franz Ludwig von Cancrin 1792 ein Lehrbuch zur buergerlichen Baukunst, in dem die funktionalistischen Positionen noch weiter getrieben werden und geradezu erklärt wird, dass Schönheit zur Vollkommenheit von Architektur nicht unbedingt erforderlich sei. 

Thieme-Becker I, 12. First and only edition. Wilhelm von Abbema (1812–1889) attended the Art Academy in Düsseldorf in 1830–33, where he studied landscape painting in the class of Johann Wilhelm Schirmer, and trained himself as an engraver in landscape and architecture. Starting from 1832 he produced the first etchings after own landscape drawings from the surroundings of Düsseldorf. With a small water stain in the inner fold, not touching the image, with a few faint spots. Fine landscape studies in lithography, the illustrations vignette-like free-standing on the sheet.





Bigelow, Lyman Goodale. Artistic photography and how to attain it. Philadelphia, Benerman & Wilson 1876. 24 pages text, 12 original photographs mounted on card and set within red ruled borders. Original blind stamped and gilt lettered dark red cloth, One corner

bumped, and some light foxing and slight dustiness to the contents, which are a little loose in the binding, but a good copy of a scarce work.

Lyman Goodale Bigeow (1841-1940) was born at Springfield township,
Oakland Co, MI on 30 June 1841. He served in the Civil War as Sergeant and
later a Lieutenant, and subsequently became a photographer/artist. He invented the Bigelow Revolving Photographic Background, which he sold years
earlier to the Scovill Manufacturing Company. Later he discovered, patented,
and sold the Bigelow Calcinated Retouching Flour, a Mr. Eastman from New
York had invited Lyman to come to work for Eastman's company. But he
turned the offer down. He became known for his beautiful studio portraitures in both Detroit, Michigan, and St. Joseph, Missouri. The text covers the
following subjects: Artistic sight; balance of lines; chiaroscuro; backgrounds
and accessories; composition, rules and maxims; the studio; formulae well
proved and used by the author in producing the work employed to illustrate
this book; printing and toning formulae. The photographs with portraits of
single men and women, children and group portraits.






A sumptuous fashion publication, edited by Otto Haas-Heye, the chief couturier of one of Berlin's leading fashion houses, Moden-Alfred-Marie. Haas-Heye's designs are both elegant and stylish and ,Graphische Modeblätter', produced in a limited edition and finely printed and handcoloured, reflected this. The first issues comprise a single plate illustrating a model gown with a further line drawing of the silhouette and a swatch of silk or twill indicating the fabrics to be used. Later issues with a number of sketches on a particular theme: bridal gowns, winter coats and walking costumes, summer gowns and, in the final issue, an introduction to the business' new premises. There are additional contributions to the later issues by Magda Killisch-Horn, Sonja von Gleichen-Russwurm and Alice Truebner. Very scarce, only two copies located on KVK. One in a German library the other the V & A copy lacks the four pages with photographic images.



The painter and lithographer Joseph Carl Grünwedel was born 1815 in Pappenheim, he died in 1895 in Munich. An early work by the artist, probably made on the occasion of an obscure jubilee of the count of Pappenheim's family at his birth place Pappenheim. Front cover with a long lithographic dedication to the count of Pappenheim. Overall very nice condition of a scarce and charming suite of illustrations in bright contemporary colouring.

Ungers. - The maquette for the published booklet edited and compiled by Stefan Wewerka of one of Rainer's most important publications on architecture. Arnulf Rainer, who had a studio in Berlin since the mid 1960s, was invited by O. M. Ungers to organize and publish his reflections on architecture within his series on the theory and practise of architecture published at the TU Berlin. "In seinen ausdrucksstark gedrängten Zeichnungen und den übermalten Fotografienvon Gebäuden ging es Rainer nicht um Akte der Zerstörung, sondern um eine 'plastische Überabeitung der Stadträume und Bauten" (Bettina Rudhof nach Rem Kohlhaas). Kohlhaas who was a pupil of Ungers used this booklet as an example for his own contemplations and concepts of architecture for the Biennale of Architecture in 2014. A copy of the printed booklet is included.



First and only edition. A highly interesting museological plate book documenting the restoration efforts and documentation by the artists and architects Heideloff, Görgel and Rothbart at the ducal structure in the fortress of the Veste Coburg between 1837 and 1864. The centre of their rebuilding project was the so-called Reformation- or Luther-room, to commemorate Martin Luther's stay there in 1530. Completely adorned in neo-Gothic style, the whole room was put on the stage as an authentic piece of interior decoration as seen by Luther himself. Only in the beginning of the 20th century with changing standards in museology the whole structure was rebuilt and the book now can be qualified as an original source document for the study of art history and museology. Rare trade catalogue by the Chance Brothers and Company, the leading glass manufacturer and a pioneer of British glassmaking technology in the 19th century. Chance Brothers was amongst the earliest glass works to carry out the cylinder process in Europe. "In 1837, it made the first British cylinder blown sheet glass with the expertise of Georges Bontemps, a famous French glassmaker from Choisy-le-Roi who had purchased the secret of the stirrer after the deaths of Pierre Louis Guinand and Joseph von Fraunhofer, the pioneers of the manufacture of high-precision lenses for observatory telescopes. Bontemps agreed to share the secret with Chance Brothers and stayed in England to collaborate with Chance for six years. In 1848 under his supervision

a new Chance plant was set up for the manufacture of crown and flint glass for telescopes and cameras" (King, Henry C. & Jones, Harold Spencer. The History of the Telescope (2003), p. 176ff.). Just three other companies in Britain made glass in the same way, Pilkington of St. Helens, Hartleys of Sunderland and Cooksons of Newcastle. During 1832, Chance Brothers became the first company to adopt the cylinder method to produce sheet glass, and became the largest British manufacturer of window and plate glass, and optical glasses. Withdrawn stamp on front paste-down. No copy of this book traced on OCLC in American institutions. A few brown spots, else a nice copy.








This engraving depicts a large room containing an assortment of mathematical, optical, philosophical, and musical instruments. In one corner of this room, a group of men sit at and stand around a table, deep in discussion. Title aside, the image represents the cabinet of the Académie des Sciences, which moved to the Louvre in

I699. The image was created in Paris in I7II-I7I2 by Sébastien Leclerc (I637–I7I4), an engraver, engineer, and professor of perspective. Sheetsize: 435 x 292 mm.



Borghini

is the first writer to suggest that talking about art can be an artform in its own right, a point that has become increasingly clear in more recent art literature. Borghini includes in his work some philosophical background, not least regarding the respective merists of painting and sculpture, technical information, art theoretical criteria and their art critical application, and an art historical survey" (Frangenberg, in The Catholic Hist.
